All the baseboards were removed, then reinstalled, caulked and painted to avoid unsightly quarter round or shoe moldings. All the jams were undercut. The layout of the wood planks are organized and symmetrical.

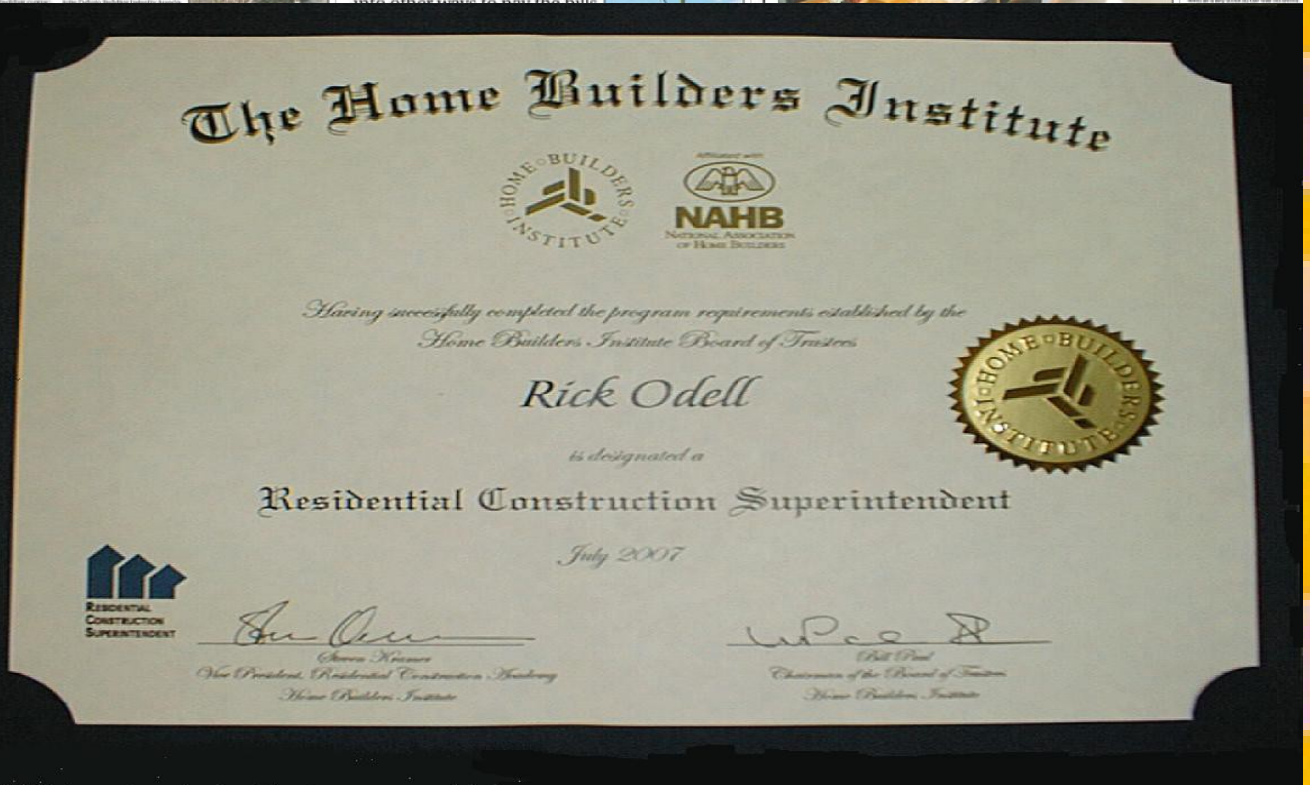

It was also through this period that I received my certificate for the successful completion of the Residential Construction Superintendent course.

As the newspaper reported, the economic times demanded a change of thinking. . . . a diversification of product. I developed a line of musical instruments. Dulcimers, an Appalachian stringed musical instrument.



Hurricane Charlie August, 2004

I was self employed in Michigan remodeling when Charlie hit Southwest Florida and I wanted to help with the rebuilding.

I relocated to Florida in February, 2005 and assisted in the remodeling of approximately a dozen homes. In most instances a sub-contractor repaired the roof. Then working with crew and sub-contractors the interior areas with water damage were demolished. Mold abatement was performed. The mechanicals, insulation, wallboard, trim & paint, kitchen / bath, appliances, flooring were replaced as required and all inspections were completed.
